Roelof Goris and his Contribution to the Lexicography of Sasak

The *taalambtenaar* R. Goris is best known for his study of Old Balinese inscriptions, but one of his duties was to compile a dictionary of Sasak. This has remained little known, despite the fact that it uses a wide range of ethnographic sources and entailed an exploration of Sasak morphology. Perhaps the time of publication was a problem, as well as the use of Dutch.
